What is the Education and Labour Market Longitudinal Platform (ELMLP)?



- An environment that allows the integration of anonymized variables from core education-related administrative sources with those from other selected datasets.



- Access to longitudinal cohort analysis for a better understanding of student pathways through the postsecondary education system and the impact of education and training on career prospects in term of earnings.



- Does not contain any personal identifiers. Anonymous linkage keys are created using the Social Data Linkage Environment (SDLE).



- Is not a large integrated dataset, but rather a relational data environment.



Commitment to data security

- As part of our mandate, guaranteeing the security of sensitive statistical information within Statistics Canada is a top priority.
- We deploy state-of-the-art tools and processes that prevent disclosure and ensure the confidentiality and privacy of individual data.
- Only aggregate non-confidential data are released outside of Statistics Canada.



Core Files of the ELMLP

The core files (the “body”) of the ELMLP are the “Postsecondary Student Information System” (PSIS), the “Registered Apprenticeship Information System” (RAIS) and the “T1 Family File” (T1FF).

Core Files- PSIS (2009/10 onwards)

Postsecondary Student Information System

- PSIS is a national administrative survey on enrolments and graduates of Canadian public postsecondary institutions
- PSIS collects information pertaining to the programs and courses offered at an institution, as well as information regarding the students themselves
- This information is available from the PSIS cross-sectional files. With the ELMLP these files can be linked longitudinally.



Core Files- RAIS (2008 onwards)

Registered Apprenticeship Information System

- The RAIS compiles data on the number of registered apprentices taking in-class and/or on-the-job training in trades that are either Red Seal or non-Red Seal and where apprenticeship training is either compulsory or voluntary.
- It also compiles data on the number of provincial and interprovincial certificates granted to apprentices or trade qualifiers (challengers).



Core Files- T1FF (1992 onwards)

T1 Family File

- The T1FF is a source of data on income, tax credits, and deductions for individuals who have completed a T1 tax return and their dependants.
- The T1FF that is part of the ELMLP "core files" is a T1FF limited to the population of PSIS and RAIS. Thus, to be found in the T1FF of the core files, an individual must be in the PSIS or RAIS database for at least one reference year.
 - The ELMLP contains other T1FF files that represent other populations (for example, a T1FF representing elementary and secondary students in British Columbia).
- The number of tax records is not limited to the number of years an individual was in school. All their available tax records from 1992 onward will be included in the PSIS-RAIS-T1FF file as long as they are found in PSIS or RAIS for at least one year.

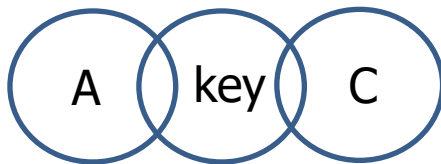

Integrating data files within the ELMLP: Two ways

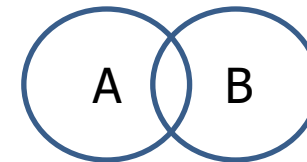
Type 1: Integrate File A with File C using a concordance key file that contains matched anonymized ID variables from each of the two files.

For example, PSIS and Census 2016 use different ID variables. The PSIS-RAIS-Census 2016 concordance key file allows the two files to be integrated.



Type 2: Integrate File A with File B using an anonymized ID variable that is present on both files (Register_Group_ID).

For example, PSIS and PSIS-RAIS-T1FF files both have the ID variable Register_Group_ID. It is possible to integrate these two files without a separate concordance key file.



The three Core Files do not need a concordance key file to be integrated.

Supplementary files: Type 1 (PSIS-RAIS concordance key files)

- Used for integrating PSIS and RAIS with other Statistics Canada data files
- Population covers individuals found in PSIS, RAIS or both
- Data users must request the microdata files, plus the concordance key. For example: PSIS, the 2016 Census microdata, and the PSIS-RAIS-Census 2016 key

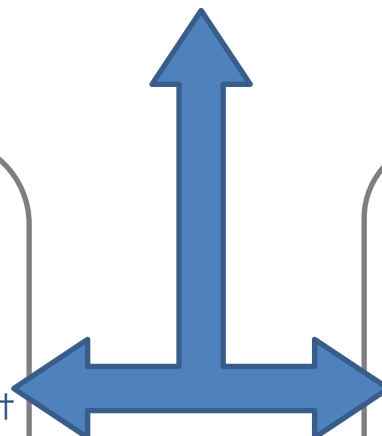

- Data files generally provided by external organizations (ESDC, provincial ministries)
- Anonymized key is built-in to the microdata file for integrating with PSIS, RAIS
- Many have specialized T1FF files or concordance key files that include **all persons** in the microdata file, regardless of whether they are in PSIS or RAIS

Education and Labour Market Longitudinal Platform - Recap

- The ELMLP is not a large integrated dataset, but rather a relational data environment. It uses unique, anonymized IDs to allow integration of data files while protecting confidentiality.
- There are three “core files” (PSIS, RAIS, T1FF) and 15+ supplementary files (concordance keys or other microdata) that pertain to students and registered apprentices. All supplementary files can be integrated with the three core files.
- The core files and some concordance key files (e.g. IMDB, Census, LAD) are generally updated in March of each year. Other supplementary files are updated on an ad-hoc basis.

Custom tabulations – levels of complexity

- **Simple requests (\$)**

- Uses pre-existing methodology
- Produces estimates like those in our annually produced tables (e.g. persistence rate, graduation rate, employment earnings – links on slide 35)
- Can make small changes like refining to a specific subpopulation

Examples:

- Employment earnings of graduates from Greater Toronto Area
- Geographic mobility of health care graduates



Custom tabulations – levels of complexity

- **Complex requests (\$\$)**

- Requires extra coding or development work (e.g. using derived/modified variables, including additional data sources)
- Needs to be completed by someone with a higher level of knowledge about the workings of our production systems and advanced coding skills

Examples:

- Adjusting income of a graduate based on family size
- Employment income of new students regardless of graduation status
- Median of the sum of employment income over 10 years
- Count of graduates by racialized identity (Census)



Community-level data : what is possible?

- Custom tabulations are limited by confidential vetting rules
- Harder to get useful information from tables with many small cells
- Consider:
 - **Size of population of interest
 - Education levels of interest (e.g. bachelor's degree, college diploma)
 - Demographic characteristics (e.g. age, gender, Canadian or International student. Characteristics from Census have a bigger impact on sample size than those from PSIS)
 - Outcomes of interest (e.g. graduation rate, employment earnings)
 - Level of detail of field of study (e.g. CIP primary groupings or STEM and BHASE*)
- We will work with you to find a solution – prioritizing helps!

*business, humanities, health, arts, social sciences and education



Case study: Invest in Canada

- In partnership with Centre for Special Business Projects (StatCan)
- **Objective:** to determine the pool of STEM graduates available across Canada at a granular geographical level and measure mobility two years after graduation
 - When feasible, looked at the Census Metropolitan Area level, and individual STEM fields of study
- **Purpose:** to help Invest in Canada advise foreign investors on the nature and distribution of STEM talent in Canada
